

Accessibility Information for Big Sky Documentary Film Festival Venues and Activity areas

Missoula Public Library

- Accessible parking is available on Main Street as well as a wheelchair accessible entrance
- Accessible parking spaces are also available in the parking garage on Front Street as well as a wheelchair accessible door.
- The elevator runs from the parking garage all the way to the 4th floor (where festival events take place).
- Restrooms are located near the elevator on all floors.
- The restroom on the 4th floor has a wheelchair accessible stall in both the men's and women's restroom, as does the restroom on the 1st floor.

The Roxy Theater

- Each theater has two dedicated wheelchair-accessible areas. These are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Missoula Community Theater

- MCT is a fully ADA accessible theater venue
- An elevator runs from the lobby to the second and third floor, and a small lift stage left provides access to the production/ backstage floor.
- Several wheelchair accessible spaces are available on the main floor of the theater and on the balcony. There are also several seats for anyone who would require not using stairs.
- Automatic doors are available at the lobby entrance.
- There are three designated accessible parking spots, one of which is van accessible.

UC Theater

- An elevator runs from the first floor of the University Center to the 3rd floor where the UC Theater is located (where festival events will take place)
- Ramps are located on the West and North entrances of the building.
- The closest ADA parking spots are on the North side of the building.
- Removable chairs in the front of the theater can be relocated to make room for wheelchair access.

Downtown Missoula

- All of Downtown is accessible, except for one corner - the corner of N. Pattee St. and E. Front St. by the Elks Lodge.
- There is ADA parking on every block face and in the garages.
- There are no public restrooms open this time of year, but the majority, if not all Downtown businesses have accessible restrooms available.
